ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION POLICY STATEMENT

- 3.7. Maintain an environmental policy statement as the first point of reference to ensure that Unicorn Fire & Safety Solutions activities are conducted in compliance with the law and international conventions and to provide a broad overview of the Company's' polices on environmental issues
